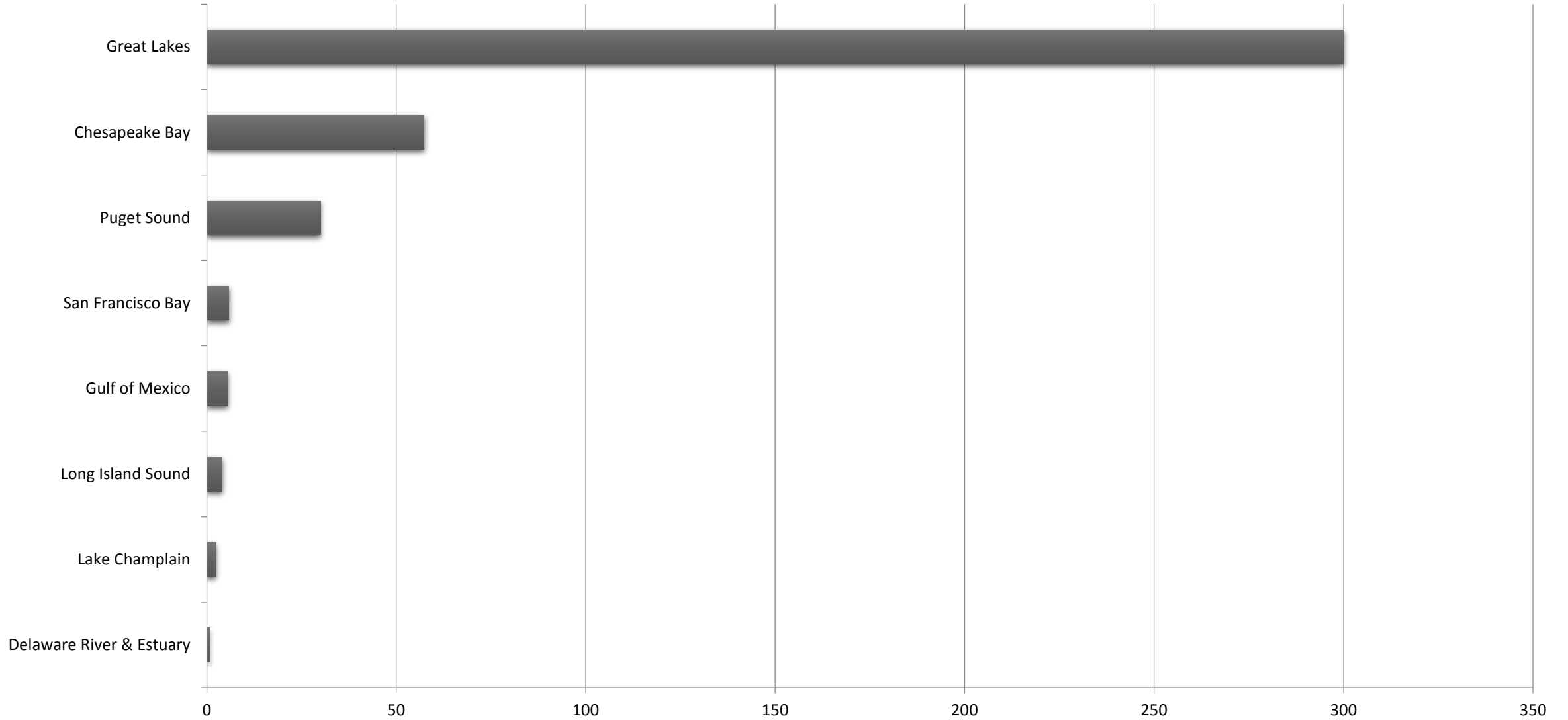
Improved Water Releases in the next NYC Delaware River Water Management Plan (OST/FFMP) that:
