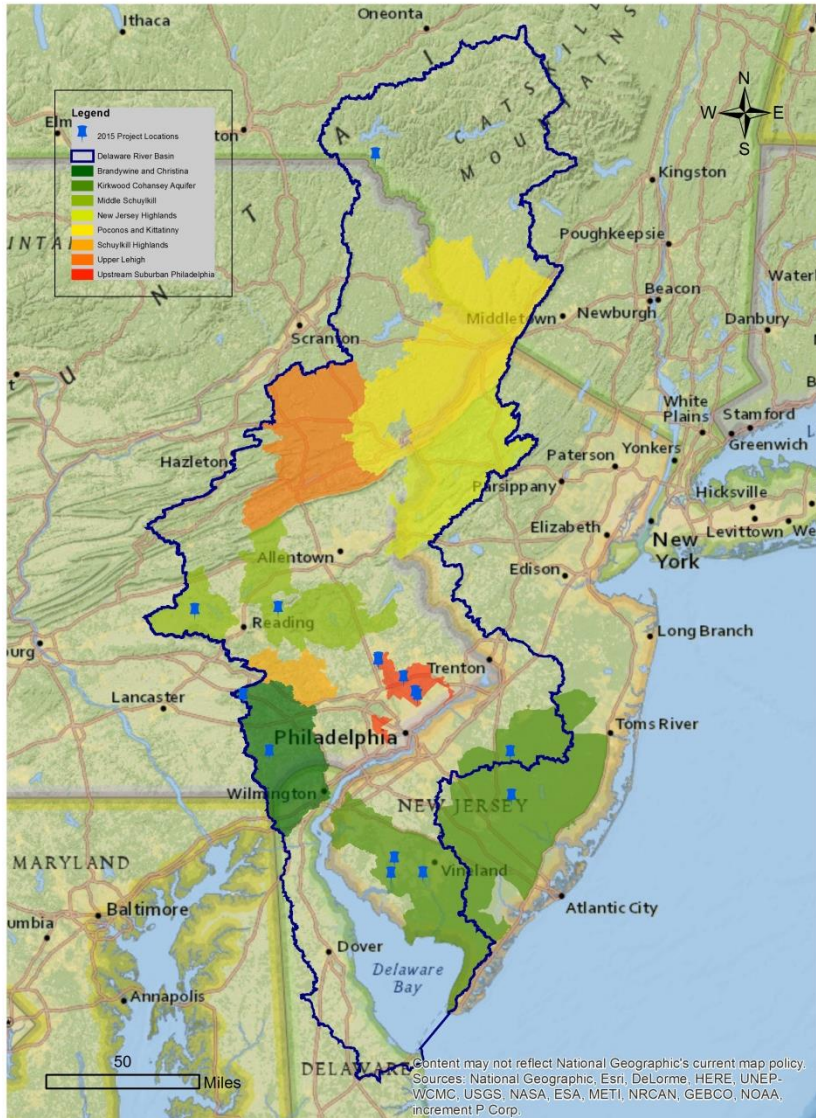
Dedicated to restoring the water quality and habitats of the Delaware River and its tributaries.

DRRF Overview and Update

2015 Delaware River Restoration Fund Projects



- DRRF funding via DRWI \$35 million investment
- NFWF will award ~ \$2 million per year for restoration
- Other public and private funding under development
- 2015 grant cycle:
 - 34 proposals, \$5.8 million request
 - 15 awards, \$2.1 million
- Next RFP planned for release in December 2015



Two Grant Categories

Targeted Implementation Grants

- ✓ Geographic Cluster Priorities
- ✓ On-the-ground WQ improvements
- ✓ Non-profits and local governments
- ✓ Partner w/*Cluster Team* (see list)
- ✓ \$50,000 - \$500,000 each
- ✓ Match of 25% - 50% (and more!)

Innovation Grants

- ✓ Cross-cutting w/widespread benefits
- ✓ Remove barriers to improving WQ
- ✓ Non-profits, local governments, academic institution
- ✓ Appropriate partnership
- ✓ \$50,000 - \$100,000 each
- ✓ Match of at least 50% encouraged
